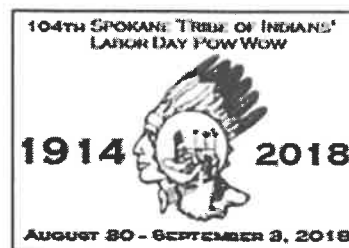

Terms and Conditions

The Non-Profit Permanent Stand is open to any non-profit organization within the boundaries of the Spokane Indian Reservation. To qualify, the organization must submit proof of its tax exempt status, and have at least one Spokane Tribal member sponsor the booth (if the organization is not directly affiliated with the Spokane Tribe of Indians.) The organization will be limited to sale of food and drinks **only**. One winner will be selected by lottery from applications received by Friday June 1, 2018. The final drawing will be held at special Pow Wow Committee meeting on the same day, and the Selectees notified soon after.

The Selectee will not be charged a vendor fee, but it is the responsibility of the Selectee to make sure the stand is left in clean condition, and vacated ***no later*** than 10am on Monday, September 10, 2018. A final walk-through with a pow wow committee member will be conducted prior to final key turn-in. If the stand is left in need of cleaning, the Selectee will be charged a clean-up fee of \$50 per man hour of labor. Any lost keys will be charged a replacement fee by the Spokane Tribe of Indians that reflects both fair market value to replace the lock hardware, and covers the cost of labor. Any damages to the stand will also be billed by the Spokane Tribe of Indians to the Selectee reflecting fair market value of parts and the cost of labor.

Approximately one month before the pow wow, the Vendor Coordinator will contact Selectees to determine check-in times. At a mutually agreed time, (anytime on or after Thursday August 2, 2018,) the Vendor Coordinator (or designee) will walk through the assigned stand with the Selectee to verify the condition of the stand prior to key transfer.

The Spokane Tribal Labor Pow Wow Committee is not responsible for lost, stolen or vandalized property. All food vendors are required to have a 20lb Fire Extinguisher on site (which will be visually verified on Thursday August 30, 2018.) Any extension cords used need to be heavy duty construction grade.
