Information about the Spokane Tribe Higher Education (HE) & Adult Vocational Training (AVT) tuition assistance programs

The Spokane Tribe Higher Education and AVT tuition assistance programs help students pursue their dreams of obtaining a higher education degree, certificate, or license. The Spokane Tribe of Indians (STOI) Education Department aids in assistance with items such as tuition, book reimbursement, and a monthly stipend to offset the cost of education. We highly encourage you to apply for all other outside scholarship programs that you may be eligible for in order to assure that your education needs in regard to expense are being met.

Although our Higher Education and Adult Vocational Training programs differ in the sense that an AVT program can be considered "short term" whereas HE is always long term, our dates and deadlines remain the same for AVT "long term" (11 months-24 months) programs.

Spokane Tribe Higher Education & Long Term AVT Timelines

- Scholarship Application Open: February 15th, 2018; Fall 2018/Priority
- Scholarship Application Close: May 15th, 2018
- Application Review Period: June 1st-30th, 2018

Notification to Students of Award

Award notification (both awards and declines) will begin June 15th, 2018 depending on when applications were reviewed. Applications will be reviewed in the order they were received. Notifications may occur as late as August 15th, 2018. **Awardees/Recipients must respond to their award letters no later than August 31, 2018.**

Items that may delay your Award

In addition to submitting a complete Higher Education or Adult Vocational Training application to either the Program Manager or Outreach Coordinator with all supporting documents applicable to new student/entering freshman or returning student, students must also ensure that they **1. Complete their Financial Aid (FA) packages with their school of choice.** Student must also **2. Register for Fall 2018 courses.** Furthermore, some schools may require their freshman to **3. Fulfill an Orientation prior to being allowed to enroll for classes.** **To ensure your FA package is complete you will need to contact your schools Financial Aid office and/or respond to any items the FA office may send you in the mail. If you miss their FA deadlines to be awarded fall funds you will then be ineligible for funding through the STOI Higher Ed or AVT program(s).**

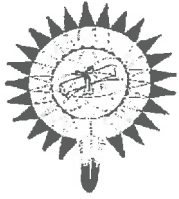
Scholarship Post-Acceptance Documents Required

Should your original application be missing an item that is non-essential (policies & procedures acknowledgement form, student agreement form, etc), awarded students will receive a list of those additional documents in their notification letters.

- Deadline for non-essential items: August 31st, 2018

Frequently asked questions:

When applying

Q: How can I get an application to apply?

A: You can request an application be emailed or mailed to you by contacting the Education Department manager or Outreach Coordinator at micaela.carroll@spokanetribe.com or sasha.reuben@spokanetribe.com. Please keep in mind that if you are requesting an application be emailed or mailed we ask that you do so at least 15 business days prior the deadline to ensure that your application reaches you in time. We cannot be responsible for delays in email or postal mail. You can also download a printable version at <https://www.spokanetribe.com/education> on the main page under “printable documents”.

Q: Do I have to submit all pages of the application back?

A: Yes. If pages are missing your application will be considered incomplete, therefore you will be ineligible for funding not considered as a possible awardee.

Q: What if I do not have my college academic transcripts on or before the deadline?

A: All documents relevant to new/entering freshman or returning student must be submitted at the same time your application is submitted. If you do not have a copy of your most recent college transcript on or before the deadline you will need to wait until the next deadline (winter or spring).

Q: What is the application process?

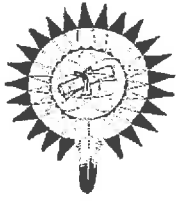
A: There is a seven-step process: 1. Submit general STOI Higher Education or AVT application + all required documents back to the department. 2. STOI Education Department will review your application before or during the review period (dependent upon when your application submission was received) and determine eligibility. 3. STOI Education Department will then correspond with the college that you have listed on your application to request information in regard to your Financial Aid package for outside grants, scholarships, student loans, or other outside money that you may be receiving to pay for tuition. 4. STOI Education Department will then utilize that information to determine a dollar amount toward tuition that the program may be able to assist with. 5. If awarded funds, STOI will then notify you via official paper mail. 6. The applicant must then respond to the award letter and complete the Post-Acceptance verification process. 7. Become a Spokane Tribe Higher Education or Adult Vocational Training awardee/student.

Q: Is there anything I need to do during the review time?

A: Yes. Applicants must ensure that their Financial Aid packages through their college of choice is complete. An incomplete Financial Aid package will deem you ineligible for funding through the STOI Education Department for any program you wish to seek funds for.

Q: When should I apply?

A: We encourage you to apply as soon as applications become available to allow enough time for the department to process your paperwork. Waiting to apply until the day of the deadline is never a good idea.

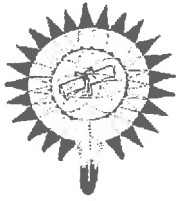
- Scholarship Application Open: February 15th, 2018

Q: Are there opportunities available for Summer?

A: If you are a current student during the 2018-2019 school year and you have not used the entire \$8500 per student per academic year allowance toward tuition and you show a financial need (you are not receiving other outside grants or scholarships to cover your expenses per your Financial Aid office) for tuition assistance during the summer then yes, opportunities are available. You must also be in **graduating status**, meaning you need summer courses to graduate that term or the next, or the courses you wish to take are only offered during the summer. Please contact the Program Manager for more information.

Eligibility requirements overview

Higher Education

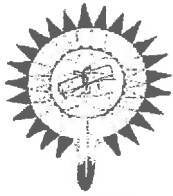
- Be an enrolled member of the Spokane Tribe
- Currently hold a High School Diploma or General Education Development certificate (with the exception of High School Seniors who may *apply* before their diplomas/certificates are awarded)
 - High School seniors must submit verification of High School Diploma or GED, as applicable as soon as their diploma/certificates are received. This is normally expected to be submitted no later than June 30th of each year prior to the fall start date.
- Be enrolled in a two (2) or four (4) year accredited college *and* be eligible for Title IV grants, state funding, and other institutional aid through FAFSA;
 - For entering Freshman/High School Seniors they must have *applied* to a 2-year or 4-year college at the time their Spokane Tribe education application is submitted
 - Entering Freshman and High School Seniors must also submit documentation of college application documentation (if done online verification is given through email) at the time their Spokane Tribe education application is submitted
- Entering Freshman/High School Seniors are required to provide college acceptance letter no later than June 30th to be considered for funding
- Apply for FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) annually at fafsa.ed.gov
 - Submit a copy of Student Aid Report (SAR) at the time of Spokane Tribe Education application submission with each new application
 - Reference fafsa.ed.gov in regard to when you can renew your FAFSA to obtain a new Student Aid Report
 - All questions pertaining to a FAFSA should be looked up at fafsa.ed.gov as this program is outside of the Spokane Tribe Education Department and is not a Tribal program. We are unable to help you determine your FAFSA eligibility. However, we are able to assist you on what you need to do to apply for FAFSA.
- Be enrolled as a full time student;
 - Part time and Graduate students will be considered for tuition and books only in accordance with a returned Financial Needs Analysis (FNA) forms and not to exceed Education Department CAP's

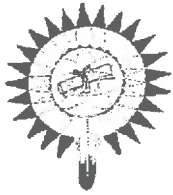

New student checklist

What do I need to submit to be eligible for Higher Education funding as **NEW STUDENT**? Students are eligible for assistance as a **new student** if they have never received higher education funding for a 2 year or a 4 year degree and if they currently do not hold a BA/BAS, Masters or Doctorate, regardless if a previous degree was or wasn't funded through the Spokane Tribe Education Department.

Below you will find a list of the items that you will need to submit along with your complete application:

- **Complete Spokane Tribe Higher Education application**
 - Each page must be filled out *completely*. Each signature line needs a legible signature.
 - Email and Social Security Number required.
- **Copy of 2018-2019 Student Aid Report**
 - All pages of SAR must be submitted. Available at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- **Copy of certificate of Indian blood (CIB) and enrollment card.**
 - If your enrollment card is expired you will need to see Vicki Raymond, enrollment officer, to obtain a new enrollment card. You can contact her at vickir@spokanetribe.com. You must submit a copy of your CIB or enrollment card yourself. The STOI Enrollment Officer cannot submit this documentation for you.
- **Copy of high school diploma, GED, most recent college transcript- whichever is applicable**
 - **High school diploma** required on or before June 30th
- **Documentation of application to two outside scholarships**
 - Documentation must be date and time stamped if you are submitting to STOI Education Department via email; confirmation must show student name. Outside scholarships that are being mailed are asked to be submitted as a copy of what you are mailing.
- **Signed acknowledgement form for policies & procedures**
 - Students can request an acknowledgment form in person during office hours if they are unable to obtain this via spokanetribe.com/education under "printable documents" under tab policies & procedures
- **Copy of College Acceptance Letter**
 - High School Seniors must have applied to a 2 year or 4 year accredited college at time of application submission and must submit documentation showing as such.
- **Minimum of 1-page single spaced letter outlining your education goals *must be signed***
 - What are you going to school for? What motivates you? What do you plan to do upon graduation?
- **Copy of upcoming class registration**
 - Some students may have this and some may not. Please make sure to keep in contact with Program Manager as to where you are at with registration. Often, universities and/or community colleges require students to attend a freshman orientation before class registration. Registration must be complete for schools to determine financial need via financial aid package. **If you do not register for classes with enough time for your school to complete your Needs Analysis prior to the beginning of the term you wish you start with your eligibility start date will move to the next term. Generally we ask that the Needs Analysis is able to be complete at least 30 days prior to the start of your first term.**

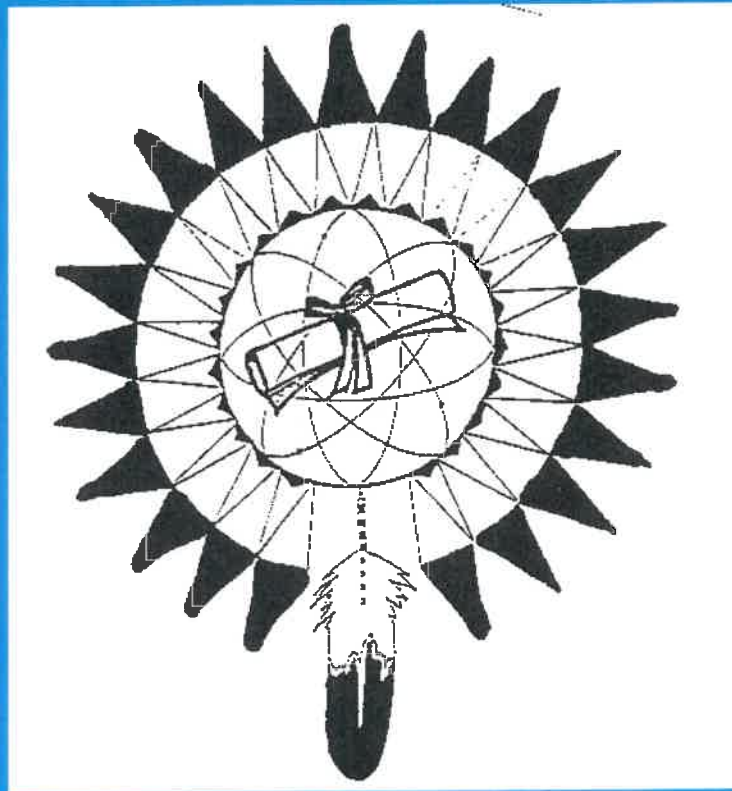
Returning/Continuing student checklist

What do I need to submit to be eligible for Higher Education funding as RETURNING STUDENT? Students are eligible for assistance as a **returning student** if they have received higher education assistance through the Spokane Tribe Education Department in the past, regardless of how much time has passed, and currently **do not hold a BA/BAS, Masters or Doctorate**, regardless if a previous degree was or wasn't funded through the Spokane Tribe Education Department. If there has been a period of 6 months to 1 year or more between the time you last attended college and last received Spokane Tribe Higher Education Assistance, you will need a **new letter of intent** and/or if you are returning and plan to attend a different college than the last time you received Spokane Tribe Higher Education assistance, you will also need to include a **copy of your new college acceptance letter**.

- **Complete Spokane Tribe Higher Education application**
 - Each page must be filled out *completely*. Each signature line needs a legible signature.
 - Email and Social Security Number required.
- **Copy of 2018-2019 Student Aid Report**
 - All pages of SAR must be submitted. Available at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- **Copy most recent college transcript**
 - **Transcripts** that include your most recent college grades must clearly show credits earned, attempted, term GPA and overall GPA
- **Documentation of application to two outside scholarships**
 - Documentation must be date and time stamped if you are submitting to STOI Education Department via email; confirmation must show student name. Outside scholarships that are being mailed are asked to be submitted to Program Manager as a copy of what you are mailing.
- **Signed acknowledgement form for policies & procedures**
 - Students can request an acknowledgment form in person during office hours if they are unable to obtain this via spokanetribe.com/education under "printable documents" under tab policies & procedures
 - **Must be renewed annually for continuing students.**
- **Copy of upcoming class registration**
 - Some students may have this and some may not. Please make sure to keep in contact with Program Manager as to where you are at with registration. Often, universities and/or community colleges require students to attend a freshman orientation before class registration. Registration must be complete for schools to determine financial need via financial aid package. **If you do not register for classes with enough time for your school to complete your Needs Analysis prior to the beginning of the term you wish you start with your eligibility start date will move to the next term. Generally we ask that the Needs Analysis is able to be complete at least 30 days prior to the start of your first term. Please reference Registration/Final Grades page.**

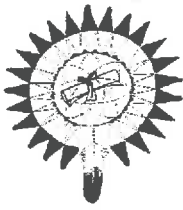
Other documents may be requesting and are depending upon the amount of time that has passed since you last received assistance. These items will fall under "non-essential" items and will be requested after review of your higher education application.

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Higher Education Application

What types of assistance could I be eligible for?

After your financial aid Scholarships & Grants \$1,000 or greater have been calculated and applied to the cost of tuition, should there be an unmet need in regard to tuition & room and board (room and board applicable to entering freshman only), the Spokane Tribe Higher Education program may be able to assist with:

Up to \$8500 in tuition assistance per academic year

- Undergraduate & graduate students
- Determined on an as-need/unmet basis after receipt of higher education application + supporting documents & after receipt of financial aid information as determined by your educational institution

Up to \$3,000 in monthly stipends per academic year

- Undergraduate students only per STOI Education Policies & Procedures
- Released to students on a monthly basis at \$150 for half of the month attended or \$300 for each full month that the student attends
- Applicable for full time students (12 or more academic credits per term) only
- Must work less than 31 hours per week to qualify

Up to \$600 in book reimbursement award assistance

- For full-time, part-time, undergraduate and graduate students

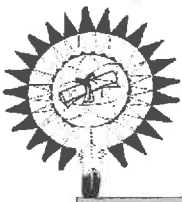
To be eligible for the items listed above, as an applicant, you must also be in good standing with Federal Financial Aid. Additionally, you must be a Spokane Tribal Member and currently possess a high school diploma or a general education development certificate (GED). Furthermore, at the time of application, the applicant must show proof of attempted enrollment in a 2 year or 4 year accredited college.

To continue with the application process, please fill out and return pages 2-8 to either the Education Program Manager or the Outreach Coordinator on or before the established deadlines listed below:

Long-term open date: February 15th, 2018, *program must begin after on or after fall 2018 and be between fall 2018 and spring 2019*

Long-term close date: May 15th, 2018

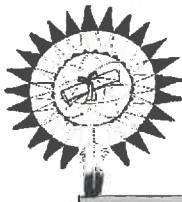

	I agree to maintain a <u>minimum GPA of 2.0</u> in both <u>term</u> and <u>cumulative GPA</u> while simultaneously carrying a minimum credit load of twelve (12) credits as a full-time student. As a part-time or Grad student, I agree to maintain a <i>minimum</i> GPA of 2.0. Should my program require a different GPA, I agree to maintain that of my program requirements.
	I will make necessary reports regarding my progress and furnish any other information requested, including intent to transfer or withdraw. Intent to transfer must be given to the Education Program Manager (EPM) at least sixty (60) days in advance of transfer. Intent to withdraw must be given at least 30 days of intent to withdraw.
	I understand that if I withdraw from school, for any reasons, before the end of the term/quarter/semester, I am to refund to the Spokane Tribe Education Program all monetary awards disbursed/advanced to me during that term/quarter/semester before I qualify for any further awards.
	Additionally, I understand that should I withdraw from classes mid-term that I am to reimburse the program for partial monthly stipend funds that had been issued in good faith that I were to continue courses for the entire month.
	I understand that Spokane Tribe Education funds may cover my education expenses related to tuition after <u>all other grants and scholarships received \$1,000 or greater have first been applied to the cost of tuition</u> . Should I receive any additional outside funding, from sources such as delayed financial aid or scholarships, including MOU scholarships, <i>after</i> Tribal funding has been disbursed, I agree to and understand that I am to reimburse the STOI Education Department for expense paid on my behalf that may have been issued as overpayment. This is applicable only in instances where overpayment on STOI's behalf has happened. The Program Manager will determine if overpayment has happened and notify the student.
	I agree should I owe the STOI Education Department money for overpayment, 0.0 grades, or other items that have placed me into payback, that I authorize the STOI Education Department to withhold any trust income (per capita or settlement) I may have in the future, or take any means necessary for collection, until full credit has been received.



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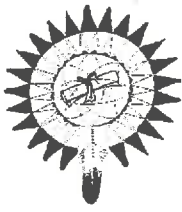
