## ALL ROYALTY CONTESTANTS REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES

These rules and guidelines, as described herein, are set forth by the Spokane Tribe of Indians Pow-wow/ Royalty Committee. All rules apply to those individuals who compete for the title of Spokane Tribal Royalty.

1. All contestants and family members should show good sportsmanship attitudes before, during, and after the competition in regards to the Committee, Judges, and other Royalty Candidates.
2. Contestants and family members will no fraternize with Judges during or after the competition in order to keep the contest fair for all involved.
3. Contestants must arrive promptly to this scheduled event. (Dressed and ready to compete at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the contest. Please check in with Velma Brehm in order to mark the time of your arrival for contest.) If contestants are late or unprepared, points may be deducted from that contestant affecting their over-all score.
4. All contestants and family members will be respectful at all times to all visiting audience members, community members, committee members, and judges when representing the Spokane Tribe.

The requirements, as set forth herein, are subject to change at the discretion of the Pow-wow/Royalty Committee.

**Royalty Expectations:** (Parents/Guardians please initial on the blank spaces acknowledging that you have read and accept each expectation should your contestant win their desired position.)

1. The title winner and attendants must represent the Spokane Tribe of Indians to the best of their ability. If for some extenuating circumstance, the title winner is unable to perform their required duties, they will immediately notify the Pow-wow/Royalty Committee so that suitable accommodations can be made or the runner-up can take the title winner's place. \_\_\_\_\_
2. The title winner shall not run for any other pageant titles/ or hold any other royalty titles until their reign for the Spokane Tribe is complete. \_\_\_\_\_
3. The title winner will serve as a positive role model for the community and as such, should refrain from any activities or behavior that may be deemed unfavorable to their title/reign. Should there be any such incidents, the Pow-wow/Royalty Committee reserves the right to strip the title winner of their privileges as a Spokane Tribal Royalty. \_\_\_\_\_
4. Title winners are required to attend all prescribed pow-wows (3 of the committee's choice and 2 of the winner's choice), community functions as requested by the Hosts of the community events, the Spokane Tribal Business Council, and the Pow-wow/Royalty Committee. Attendance will include dressing for the occasion (ie. Pow-wow regalia, dress attire, or attired deemed appropriate for the occasion). Crown and banner should be worn at all times during the said function. \_\_\_\_\_
5. Parents/Guardians are required to request the travel funds needed with enough time that checks can be cut. \_\_\_\_\_
6. A full list of rules and expectations will be read and signed upon acceptance of title/crown/banner. \_\_\_\_\_
