

ARE YOU READY FOR WILDFIRE?

HOME IGNITION ZONES

- The home itself and everything around it up to 100-200 feet is known as the 'home ignition zone.' In areas across the country where the risk of wildfire is high, the home ignition zone can extend up to 200 feet beyond the actual home structure.
- Zone 1 encircles the structure and all its attachments for at least 30 feet on all sides. Keep it lean and clean. Keep lawn mowed.
- Zone 2 is 30 to 100 feet from the home, and plants in this zone should be low-growing, well irrigated and less flammable. Reduce the vegetation and space landscaping plants.
